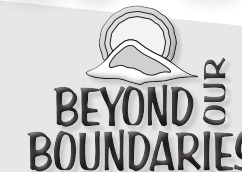

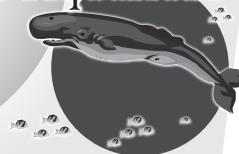

Criteria for participation: Our programs take place in the community and are designed for those with good self-care skills.

Supervision: Fun, capable, hard-working chaperones are provided and are assigned in a ratio of approximately one chaperone to four participants; those with one-to-one supervision needs must bring a chaperone.

Participants from Summit County are picked up at Giant Eagle (formerly Tops) on Howe Road in Cuyahoga Falls; Canton participants depart from Beyond Our Boundaries, Metropolitan Centre, 601 Cleveland Ave. NW, Canton, Ohio 44702. Cleveland residents picked up at Giant Eagle at 290 East Aurora Road (in the plaza with Target).

Payments: Prompt payments are appreciated! If you need a few more days to pay, please ask.

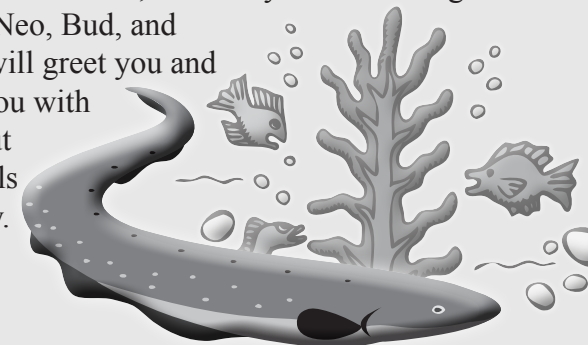

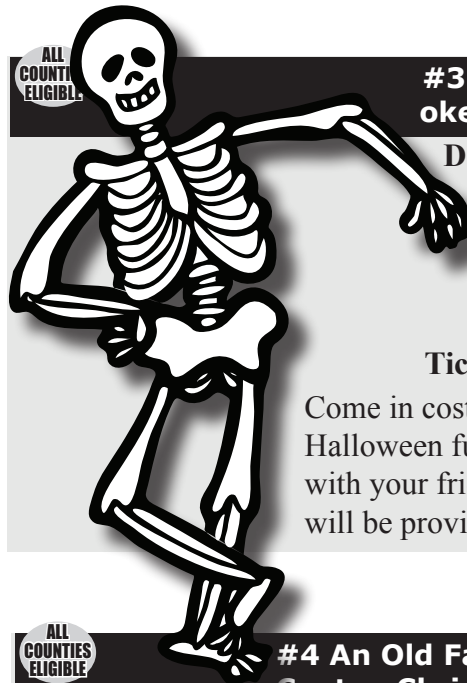
